REQUIREMENTS FOR THESIS FORMATTING

Abstracts should be typed in MS WORD, A4 format, all margins 20 mm, 1.0 spacing, paragraph 1.25 cm, width alignment.

The volume of abstracts is up to 4 pages, pages not numbered.

TITLE OF THE ABSTRACT

The abstract is to be presented in Ukrainian, typed with a paragraph indentation in Time New Roman font, size 12 pt.

Key words (up to 5 units) must be indicated below the abstract.

The main text typed in Times New Roman font, 14 pt, and should briefly reflect the relevance of the research area, the purpose, main results and their interpretation as well as a brief summary without repeating the material presented.

In the text, references to the literature sources are to be indicated by the serial number, highlighted by two square brackets, according to the list of sources in the bibliography [5, p.56].

Figures are placed in the text, aligning the caption in the center (Fig. 1. Scheme ...). Tables are placed after the paragraph in which they were first referenced.

Table 1 - Table title in bold, centered.

The list of references should be provided after the abstract in accordance with the requirements of DSTU 8302:2015.

At the end of the abstract, indicate: the name of the section, full name of the authors, author's e-mail address.

Abstracts are published in the author's version.

The Organizing Committee reserves of the right to reject publications that do not meet the requirements for formatting, and (or) contain plagiarism.
