FORMS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE:

1. Presentation at the conference (up to 5 minutes).
2. Publication of abstracts.

CONFERENCE PROGRAM provides for panel discussions in online formats.

CONFERENCE MATERIALS: An electronic collection of abstracts will be published based on the conference materials and posted on the university website in the “Electronic Conference Publications” section. Please send a file with your abstract in DOC (97-2010) format to conf_uviley@ukr.net by September 20, 2025. Please indicate the surname of the first author in the file name.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE: Participation in the conference and publication of abstracts are free of charge.

REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMATTING THE ABSTRACT

The abstracts highlight new, previously unpublished scientific results.

- Abstracts should be up to 3 pages long, typed in Microsoft Word *.doc or *.rtf format; A4 size, portrait orientation, paragraph indentation – 1.25 cm, justified alignment.
- Font: Times New Roman, main text: 14 point (abstract, keywords, tables: 12 point); line spacing: 1.5; all page margins: 20 mm. Pages should not be numbered.

Structure of abstracts:

UDC index

Author's surname and initials, academic degree

Name of the organization where the author works

Author's email address

TITLE OF THESIS

Abstract in Ukrainian (the word Abstract is not written) – no more than 3 lines.

Keywords (up to 5 phrases).

Add the authors' full names, institution, title of the abstract, abstract, and keywords in English to the abstract in Ukrainian.

The main text should be typed in Times New Roman font size 14 pt and should concisely reflect the relevance of the research direction, purpose, main results, and their interpretation, ending with a brief

summary conclusion without repeating the material already presented.

References to literary sources used in the text should be indicated by a serial number enclosed in square brackets, in accordance with the list of sources in the bibliography, [5, p. 56].

Formulas, figures, and tables should be placed after their first mention and numbered if there are several of them in the text; if there is only one, it should not be numbered.

Formulas: use Microsoft Word or Microsoft Equation formula editors. Align them in the center.

- Figures: align the caption in the center (Fig. 1. **Diagram** ...)

- Tables: Table 1 – **Table title** in bold, aligned in the center.

After the abstract, provide **a list of references** in accordance with the requirements of DSTU 8302:2015.

Abstracts are published in the author's edition.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject publications that do not meet the requirements for formatting or contain plagiarism.
